Material

- Crochet hook size 3,5 mm
- Yarn for hook 3-3,5 mm (like Cheval Blanc Sunny or Sheepjes Catona) in these colors: navy blue and beige
- Black thread
- Safety eyes 8 mm
- Tapestry and embroidery needles
- Soft stuffing

abbreviations

R: rows / rounds slst: slip stitch sc: single crochet ch: chain stitch

hdc: half double crochet dc: double crochet

inc: increase dec: decrease

* ... *: work stitches into the same stitch these chs are not crocheted, they are used to make a straight edge.

SNOUT

With the beige yarn, ch 5.

R1:	In the second stitch from the hook	
	4 sc, ch 1, under the chain, 4 sc, ch 1	(10)
R2:	1 sc, *2 hdc* x 2, 1 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc	(14)
R3:	1 sc, dec x 2, 9 sc	(12)
R4-7:	12 sc (4 rounds)	
R8:	5 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc	(14)
R9-10:	14 sc	
R11:	2 sc, inc x 3, 9 ms	(17)
Cut the yar	rn, leaving a long tail for sewing.	
Stuff lightly	y.	

EYE CONTOUR (X2)

With the beige yarn, make 6 sc in magic loop, and then, ch 1, turn.		(6)
R1:	inc x 6	(12)
Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.		

HEAD / BODY

With the navy blue yarn, make 8 sc in magic loop.		
R1:	inc x 6	(16)
R2:	[1 sc, inc] x 8	(24)
R3:	[2 sc, inc] x 8	(32)
R4-5:	32 sc	
R6:	[3 sc, inc] x 8	(40)
R7-12:	40 sc (6 rounds)	
R13:	[3 sc, dec] x 8	(32)
R14:	32 slst	
R15:	[3 sc. inc] x 8	(40)

Now we take a break in order to place the safety eyes. Stuff the head in or

Place a marker in the loop on your hook, and pause your work.

Now we take a break in order to place the safety eyes. Stuff the head in order to pin more easily the different parts. The face should be placed on the first half of the mesh row (photo 1). Place the snout in the center of that half, and pin it to the base of the head (photo 2). Then place the eyes contour, in which you should have placed the safety eyes, on both sides of the snout. Take the snout off and make sure the eyes are on the same row, then attach them. We will sew the eyes and the snout on later.

Sew the eyes contour and the snout on the head (photo 3).





ARMS (X2)

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

R13-14: 2 slst, 2 sc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, 2 slst Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff the arm.

With a piece of black thread, embroider three fingers on each paw (photo 5). Then, bring out your thread at the top of each finger: sew several knots in the same place to make a claw (photos 6 and 7). Do this for all three fingers.

LEGS (X2)

With the beig	ge yarn, ch 7.	
R1:	6 sc, ch 1, under the chain, sc, ch 1	(14)
R2:	6 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc	(16)
R3:	5 sc, 4 dc, 7 sc	
R4:	4 sc, [2 dc close together] x 3, 6 sc	(13)
R5:	3 sc, [2 dc close together] x 3, 4 sc	(10)
Change for n	avy blue yarn.	
R6-7:	10 sc	
R8:	[4 sc, inc] x 2	(12)
R9:	[2 sc, inc] x 4	(16)
R10-11:	16 sc	
R12:	[3 sc, inc] x 4	(20)
R13-15:	20 sc (3 rounds)	
R16:	[3 sc, dec] x 4	(16)
R17:	[2 sc, dec] x 4	(12)
Stuff the leg, but very lightly for the foot.		
R18:	[1 sc, dec] x 4	(8)
Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing, and fasten off.		

As for the arms, with a piece of black thread, embroider 3 fingers on each paw, and make the claws by making several knots in the same place, at the top of each finger.

POUCH

With navy blue yarn, ch 4.

R2:	ch 3 (= 1 dc), 1 dc in the same stitch, $*2$ dc* \times 4, turn	(10)

R4:	ch 3, [*2 dc*, 2 dc] x 4, *2 dc*, 1 dc,	(20)
	then, on the right side of the semi-circle, 16 sc (2 sc for each rov	vs), ch 1, turn
R5:	16 sc	(16)
Cut th	he yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.	

TAIL

With the navy blue yarn, make 6 sc in magic loop.		
R1-2:	6 sc	
R3:	2 sc, inc x 2, 2 sc	(8)
R4:	8 sc	
R5:	3 sc, inc x 2, 3 sc	(10)
R6:	10 sc	
R7:	4 sc, inc x 2, 4 sc	(12)
R8:	12 sc	
Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.		

It's time to assemble!

Stuff the tail.

ASSEMBLY AND FINITIONS

- 1. Start by sewing the pouch (photo 8), then sew the tail (photo 9).
- 2. Once these two elements are in place, sew the arms (photo 10), then the legs (photo 11): the surface to be sewn corresponds to the upper half of the crocheted part in navy blue of each member but you can sew on longer lengths if you want it to be closer to the body.

To embroider the mouth and nostrils, follow these steps:

- 3. Take a long tail of black thread. Insert your embroidery needle at the base of the right eye, in the navy blue part: tie a knot and tuck the beginning of the thread into the body. Insert your needle in the same place and bring it out at the base of the snout (photo 12). Embroider the mouth.
- 4. When you arrive at the front of the snout, take the opportunity to embroider both nostrils (photo 13). Then continue your mouth.
- 5. Once the mouth is finished, insert your needle at the base of the left eye, in the navy blue part: tie a knot and tuck the thread into the mass of the body.
